## QUERÉTARO, MEXICO

Rose and I have just returned from Mexico where I have taught in a preacher training school regularly since 2001. Querétaro is about 135 miles north of Mexico City. **Miguel Arroyo** and his family moved there in 1985 to first establish the Lord's cause in that large city. The resulting Bernardo Quintana Boulevard congregation has established several other churches in the city and nearby towns through the years. Miguel began the Bible school in 1997. Sometimes others attend the classes but the focus has always been to train gospel preachers—men who will spread the message in Mexico or in nearby Spanish-speaking countries. This work has been a great blessing to the church in Mexico!

Previous reports have told of Miguel Arroyo's tragic death in a car accident in January, 2013. This was a great loss for the church there and, of course, for the school. He was the director, recruiter and major teacher for the school. The congregation and the school have experienced some difficult times but things at present seem to be going well. A graduate of the school, **Miguel Bocanegra**, is now preaching for the congregation. Miguel Arroyo's son (**Alain**, age 32) is providing the leadership in the school and I think will do an excellent job. Alain has his father's language talents and serves as translator when an English speaker comes to teach. The number of students is growing again. It was requested I teach the course on the **Life of Christ** which I have taught there twice in previous years. Lord willing I will go back next May. **Kenny Gardner**, who preaches at **Plano East** in the Dallas area, is scheduled to go with me as co-teacher. We have worked together there before and it's always great to travel with Kenny.

When I first went to Querétaro in 2001 the church was in the beginning stages of building proper facilities for the school. It has been a long project. They have done most of the work themselves and, of course, only as funds became available. Finally, the work is almost completed. The finished product—nothing fancy, but perfect for their situation—will be a great blessing to the congregation and especially to the school.

Alain Arroyo hopes to travel to the U.S. as soon as possible to report to those who have helped support the school or have some interest in doing so. He hopes soon to obtain a visitor's visa for this purpose. If you know of brethren interested in assisting a really good work in Mexico I will be glad to put them in touch with Alain.

Many of you will be aware of the effort to help an extremely sick three-year-old boy in India. **Sonu Ruban** is the only child of a Christian couple. He is suffering from a very serious form of leukemia and treatments to try to save him are expensive. Generous Christians have given \$3700 through the church at Wylie and \$3545 through Centerville Road. Of this \$7245, most has already been sent for his treatments over the past couple of months. The remainder is being kept back to send when it is needed. Please pray for him. I will try to have an update on the situation and his condition in my next report.

I should be leaving home on July 2 for another trip to **Ghana** in West Africa. I will again teach in the preacher training school in the city of **Tamso**. My assignment this time is The Scheme of Redemption. I thank you for your prayers and support in this work.
