## QUERÉTARO, MEXICO

Rose and I are just back from this metropolis of approximately 3 million people located about 150 miles north of Mexico City. It is on the central Mexican plateau at an elevation of 6,100 feet. I like the climate...and the food...and working with the Christians there is a real joy! The church on Bernardo Quintana street has for many years operated a preacher training school which has been a great blessing to Mexico. Graduates are also working in some other nations where Spanish speaking preachers are needed. I first went to teach there in 2001 and have been every year since, sometimes twice a year.

The first congregation of the Lord's church in Querétaro was begun by **Miguel Arroyo** and his family when they moved there in 1985. Several other churches now exist in the city area and nearby towns and villages as a result of their efforts. Miguel began the Bible school and was its director and primary teacher until his tragic death in an automobile accident in January of 2013. The work carries on in spite of this dreadful event. **Alain**, Miguel's son, shares his dad's great ability with languages and now is the translator for English speaking teachers.

Rose and I were delighted to have **Kenny and Belinda Gardner** travel with us from Dallas for this work. Kenny preaches for the Plano East church and also teaches at the Brown Trail School of Preaching in Bedford, near Fort Worth. He has taught in Querétaro a few times in the past; this trip his subject was **Hermeneutics**. My topic was the book of **Revelation**. We look forward to future participation in this good work.

## Fantastic Response from Loving Christians

There has been tremendous response to a couple of benevolent needs I made known to those who receive my reports. One concerned medical assistance for **Abraham**, a preacher we know and work with in **India**. His injuries from a terrible accident on the road brought expenses his poor family could never hope to pay. Your generosity made all the difference. The English speaking preacher we work with in that area is **Raja Rao**. With Raja to translate the message, Abraham and his family want me to make sure you know of their deep gratitude.

The other need was in **Ukraine**. The continuing war with Russia in the eastern regions of the country has resulted in most Christians having to flee the area just to stay alive. They have become refugees in their own land. Homes were destroyed or had to be abandoned and many escaped with virtually no possessions. With your help the church in **Kremenchuk**, where we work twice a year, has bought two apartments to house some of these Christians. Hopefully, a third one will soon be purchased. These are *very small* and *very inexpensive* places by our standards here. The displaced Christian families are greatly blessed and are also a great blessing to the Kremenchuk church.

Early in July Rose and I will both speak at the annual **Teton Family Encampment** in Wyoming. This four-day event has a long history. Sunday worship and the Monday through Wednesday classes are all in an outdoor amphitheater in the midst of great natural beauty. Christians come from many different states. We have both participated in years past and certainly look forward to an enriching experience this time. The studies this year concern the 2<sup>nd</sup> coming of Christ, the judgment, punishment and reward. The truth will be highlighted and false doctrines answered.
